Fafen regrets inaccuracies in turnout claim

ISLAMABAD, May 14: The Free and Fair Election Network (Fafen) has regretted inaccuracies in its list of 49 polling stations that it earlier claimed had seen a voter turnout of more than 100 per cent.

After returning officers of some of the constituencies mentioned in the list found fault in it, Fafen clarified that the data was based on reports of 'citizen observers' trained to monitor the voting and counting processes on the polling day.

Putting the record straight, it said that according to official statements of the count, the turnout in polling station-155 in NA-6 was 56pc, in PS-113 in NA-7 64pc and in PS-238 in NA-52 approximately 50pc.

It said the inaccuracies might have been due to human errors by volunteer citizen observers in transcribing numbers by hand from statements of the count late at night on the election day or due to changes in the polling station numbers as listed in the polling schemes, which changed the number of registered voters at each station used as the basis for the calculation.

Fafen said the purpose of the report was to urge the Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) to release the polling station-wise data before certifying election results in any constituency, which would help reveal any problem that required further investigation and action.

The Free and Fair Election Network (Fafen) has clarified one of its report published in 'The News' titled 'At least 49 polling stations show over 100% turnout' regretting inaccuracies pointed out by the Returning officers in three constituencies, Nowshera, Charsadda, and Rawalpindi and has corrected the record for three polling stations, says a press release.

It stated that the data was based on reports of citizen observers trained to monitor the voting and counting processes on Election Day. According to official statements of the Court, the voter turnout in PS-155 in NA-6 was 56% in PS-113 in NA-7 the turnout was 64%, and in PS-238 in NA-52, the turnout was approximately 50%. Inaccuracies in Fafen's data might have been due to human errors by volunteer citizen observers in transcribing numbers by hand from statements of the count late at night on Election Day. The errors also could be due to changes in the polling station numbers, as listed in the polling schemes, which changes the number of registered voters at each station used as the basis for the calculation. The purposes of Fafen's report were to urge Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) to release polling station-wise data before certifying election results in any constituency, which will help reveal any problems that require further investigation and action. It stated that release of polling station data will enhance electoral transparency and also help address allegations of rigging by political parties and their supporters. An objective analysis of polling station vote counts and corrective actions by ECP in cases of irregularities will enhance public confidence in the electoral process.

Rigging evidence

The debate shuttles back and forth about rigging of votes in the recent elections, much of it heated and ill-informed. There is now objective evidence of rigging based on data collected by the Free and Fair Election Network (Fafen) and it relates to the impossibly high turnouts recorded at some polling stations. At least 46 polling stations out of the 8,119 which Fafen monitored recorded a turnout in excess of 100 percent, an impossibility and the clearest possible evidence of tampering with the poll result. It must be noted that the report only refers to those polling stations monitored by Fafen observers, and is not intended to present a complete national picture of electoral rigging. Unfortunately Fafen has landed in trouble and a case has been registered against the organisation for misreporting facts. The organisation has also admitted misreporting in 3 constituencies and has apologised. Yet the bulk of its evidence still holds good. Of polling stations where fraud was committed 32 are in Punjab, 10 in Sindh, six in Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa and one in Balochistan. Fafen has conceded its facts about two KPK and one Rawalpindi seat were not accurate. In addition, Fafen has commented that the ECP should investigate all results from polling stations where the turnout was suspiciously high, with 80 percent the recommended benchmark and that the ECP should render the results null and void from any polling station with these irregularities. It is for the ECP to release all polling statements on its website, and failing to do will feed the suspicion that the ECP does not have an investment in transparency within the democratic process.

There is also ample evidence of voter intimidation in Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa, Fata, Karachi and Balochistan, besides isolated seats in Punjab. Electoral observers were prevented from doing their job by 'political' workers in Karachi. Targeted terrorism throughout the campaign limited canvassing but the Fafen preliminary report notes that in broad terms the population displayed a new interest in politics, and a willingness to participate by voting in the building of democracy. There are persistent problems with the electoral process - numerous irregularities from ghost and deceased voters and fraud to lax enforcement of electoral law. Pakistan has successfully made a peaceful transition of government but it still has a long way to go in terms of refining electoral practices and reducing the opportunity for vote-rigging and other types of criminality. A strong, non-political, neutral, efficient and assertive Election Commission has now become inevitable. Irregularities aside Fafen is of the opinion that the results of the election overall are a fair representation of the will of the people. It is less easy to say this in Karachi where the ECP itself acknowledged a failure to provide an environment in which free and fair elections may be held, and in large parts of Balochistan, KP and Fata. Over 400 people died and 1,000 were injured in the run-up to the polls, women were denied the vote in parts of KP and Fata. Democracy in Pakistan remains a work in progress rather than even a half-accomplished reality.

Presiding officers will be held accountable for every vote: ECP

Commission contests allegations of rigging; says all results shown by Fafen totally incorrect

ISLAMABAD: Contesting the allegations of rigging, the Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) on Thursday said the presiding officers will be held accountable for every single ballot paper adding that the system put in place would not spare any faker.

The commission vehemently rejected a recent report by the Free and Fair Election Network (Fafen) on over 100 per cent voter turnout at 49 polling stations in the May 11 general election.

The commission said the National Database and Registration Authority (Nadra) needed two weeks to enhance its capacity to verify thousands of thumb impressions, as it continued to receive complaints. The commission has received 110 applications (complaints) within three days.

The commission met here again to look into complaints

filed by political parties and candidates, mostly calling for re-polling and recounting in their respective constituencies.

Chief Election Commissioner Justice (R) Fakhruddin G. Ebrahim chaired the proceedings.

Briefing media persons here, Secretary ECP Ishtiaq Ahmad Khan regretted that on the one hand the entire world greeted Pakistan on holding free and fair elections and the European Union and other observers also confirmed the electoral process as free and transparent barring one or two incidents of irregularities, on the other some circles were talking in total contrast.

He noted that the US President Barack Obama also congratulated Pakistan, while the British High Commissioner said the elections had added to Pakistan's dignity. "But some circles are speaking otherwise and

Army to provide security during repolling

| ECP rebuts FAFEN findings of over 100pc turnout | FAFEN admits 'human error'

The Chief Election Commissioner Justice (Retd) Fakhruddin G Ebrahim has asked the Chief of Army Staff, General Ashfaq Parvez Kayani, for the provision of complete security from military during the re-polling at certain polling stations in Karachi, Khuzdar, Bannu and South Waziristan Agency, scheduled in coming days.

The Army Chief has assured the CEC of the military's full support during the re-polling in the areas concerned, it is further learnt. During his visit to the General Headquarters (GHQ) on Thursday, the CEC called on the COAS on the pretext of thanking him for the "army's support in provision of security during the entire conduct of elections 2013," according to a press release.

However, according to informed insiders, the visit primarily aimed at seeking the military's assistance during re-polling at the 78 polling stations of six electoral constituencies and the two entire constituencies, scheduled this weekend and the next week.

The meeting between the COAS and CEC took place immediately after the Sindh Government conveyed on Thursday to the ECP that it was unable to hold the re-polling at the 43 polling stations of the Muttahida Qaumi Movement-dominated National Assembly constituency NA-250 in Karachi on May 19 due to security concerns.

Embedded with implied threats and warnings shots, the MQM's opposition to the re-polling at the said number of polling stations comes from its demand to have the re-polling done in the entire NA-250 constituency. According to an ECP source, the Sindh's Caretaker Chief Minister Zahid Qurtban Alvi informed the CEC that the re-polling in Karachi was possible only with the deployment of military troops at the polling stations concerned.

Reportedly, the military was contacted, which conveyed to the ECP on Wednesday that the armed force was ready to have the

troops deployed at all the 43 polling stations of NA-250 and Sindh Assembly constituencies PS-112 Karachi-XXIV and PS-113 Karachi-XXV, as desired by the CEC. Later on Wednesday, the ECP announced re-polling at the 35 polling stations in Khuzdar, Bannu and SWA while the CEC visited the GHQ reportedly to ensure the military's presence at all these polling stations as well that are scheduled to undergo re-polling.

The COAS, a military source shared, assured the CEC of complete cooperation during the re-polling at all the constituencies and the polling stations concerned. The army statement issued after the Thursday meeting impliedly hinted at the same. "The COAS reiterated army's continued support for providing assistance in future as well, as defined by the Election Commission of Pakistan," it added.

The Sindh Rangers and the regular military troops would be left at the ECP's disposal during re-polling in Karachi while Frontier Corps (FC) and military men would serve the same purpose in Khuzdar, Bannu and SWA, according to the military official.

The re-polling at two and four polling stations of National Assembly constituencies, NA-269 Khuzdar and NA-41 Tribal Area-VI-South Waziristan, respectively, as well as four and three

polling stations of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Assembly constituencies, PK-71, Bannu-II and PK-72, Bannu-III, respectively, will be held on May 21. The re-polling at 21 polling stations of NA-46 Tribal Area-XI-South Waziristan will be held on May 25.

Meanwhile, the Secretary ECP Ishtiaq Ahmed Khan categorically rebutted the findings of Free and Fair Elections Network (FAFEN), a local electoral watchdog which reported that 49 polling stations had 100 percent result in May 11 general elections. Pointing to stark inaccuracies in FAFEN data while talking to media, the secretary cited official figures suggesting that National Assembly's constituencies NA-5, 6, 128, 130 and 142 had 42 per cent, 47 per cent, 31 per cent, 60 per cent and 65 per cent voters turnout compared to FAFEN-reported turnout of 157 per cent, 116 per cent, 105 per cent, 132 per cent and 109 per cent in the respective constituencies.

The ECP, Khan said, received 110 electoral complaints regarding May 11 polls and ordered recounting in response to eight to nine complaints. He said the remaining complains would be redressed with the formation of election tribunals (ETs) after the notification of official results in the coming days. "There's nothing to worry about, let's move forward," he said while claiming that ballot papers were equipped with sophisticated features that allowed the detection of fake voting and prevented ballot papers misuse.

Cases against Fafen for misreporting poll results

LAHORE, May 16: Punjab police are reported to have registered at least 16 cases against the Fair and Free Election Network (Fafen), a polling observer organisation, for allegedly misreporting results of some polling stations in the province and releasing them to the media.

DIG (operations) Jawad Ahmad Dogar told Dawn on Thursday that up to 10 FIRs had been lodged in as

many city police stations on the instructions of district returning officers who stated that the results of some polling stations had been misreported by Fafen which claimed that the number of votes cast had exceeded the total number of votes.

But Fafen's chief executive officer Mudassir Rizvi said the organisation had already withdrawn its list of 'controversial' results of 40 polling sta-

tions across the country, including 22 in Punjab, after a meeting with officials of the Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP). Over 40,000 Fafen observers were engaged in the exercise.

He said the cases were registered against the organisation after it had pressed the ECP for placing statements of count by presiding officers on its website for the purpose of cor-

rection before announcing the results.

Mr Rizvi said that according to his information police had so far nominated him in 16 cases registered in Lahore and Rahim Yar Khan, adding that he did not know if cases had also been registered in other cities. He said section 505 (B) (statements conducing to public mischief) of the PPC had been invoked in the FIR.
